

# Advisory Group Paper AG (03) 08

## **Multi-Source Topic Reports**

#### Introduction

- 1. Advisory Group Paper AG (02) 10 issued in November 2002, outlined that the aim of the Multi-Source Topic Reports was to draw on the more detailed information available from the 2001 Census together with output from a range of other sources to provide a more comprehensive statistical picture of a topic area than would be provided by solely Census-based products. This paper updates the position.

- 4. Most of the reports have now been scoped. The most recent proposals to be sent out for consultation were for the report on Families which were sent out on 2 May.
- 5. The term 'multi-source topic reports' is an internal working title and we are looking for a generic name for the series. Suggestions are welcome.

## Timetable

6. The aim is for the short overviews, for most topics, to be published on the web in September 2003. Annex A also gives an indication of the likely publication date of each overview and the fuller report, but it should be noted that all dates are provisional and subject to change. More detailed focus-style reports will follow over the period 2003-05.
