1. This paper outlines progress on high level plans for 2011 Census outputs.

# **Action requested by Census Advisory Groups**

2. To note key dates in the high level output plans.

#### **Context**

3. A paper setting out aims for 2011 Census outputs went to Census Advisory Groups for comment in Autumn 2005. A UK version of the paper has recently been agreed in April 2006 and will be available on the website shortly.

Output geography and time series analysis

SDC methods for 2011 Census outputs

- 5. A paper setting out ONS' proposed small area geography policy for 2011 Census outputs went to Census Advisory Groups for comment in Autumn 2005.
- 6. A geography working group has now been established (March 2006) to coordinate the development of a National Statistics Small Area Geography Policy for 2011 and beyond and conduct the supporting programme of research. 2011 Census output key dependencies will feed into this work including:
  - policy developments for census 2011 disclosure control
  - policy developments for census time series data

- the identification of any user and statutory requirements for ward or parish level census outputs.
- 7. The geography policy for 2011 Census output will go out for wider consultation and review (including to the Census advisory Groups) in **Autumn 2006.**

### Dissemination methods

- 8. Research into dissemination methods will commence in earnest in the **Autumn 2006.**
- 9. It is intended to invite all the different data providers (NeSS, CASWEB, WICKID, SASPAC, SCROL, NOMIS) to a workshop in the Autumn of 2006 to present the best features of their systems' functionality, how they meet the needs of their user groups and to discuss the potential for a more integrated model for 2011 Census tabular output.
- 10. Key dates in the dissemination plans are detailed below:
  - Research and consultation

- Assessment of corporate functionality
- Consultation on user dissemination requirements for tabular and microdata
- Exploration of potential for partnerships with 2001 distributors (to include a workshop in Autumn 2006)
- Assessment of other off-shelf products
- Review of funding options
