1. Main points

- Total turnover generated by UK services industries increased by £478.1 billion (19.0%) from £2,511.0 billion in 2020 to £2,989.1 billion in 2021.
- The wholesale and retail trade sector, including the repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, generated the most turnover in 2021 at £1,408.9 billion, an increase of £266.0 billion (23.3%) since 2020.
- Turnover generated by businesses outside their main industrial classification (referred to as off-diagonal turnover), was estimated at £454.2 billion in 2021, representing 15.2% of total turnover (£2,989.1 billion), compared with 15.8% in 2020.
- The largest proportional increase in turnover by service type was from the creative, arts and entertainment industries, which showed an increase of 126.2% between 2020 and 2021.
- Total production (manufacturing) turnover generated by businesses within UK services industries was estimated at £71.6 billion in 2021 compared with £61.8 billion in 2020.

3. Measuring the data

The Annual Survey of Goods and Services (ASGS) estimates are based on a sample of approximately 40,000 businesses, covering 51 service industries.

ASGS data are produced in compliance with the <u>Code of Practice for Statistics</u>. Further information on this is detailed in the <u>ASGS technical report</u>, which describes the methods used to safeguard the information provided in confidence to us.

The ASGS collects turnover data primarily at the six-digit level as outlined in the <u>Statistical Classification of</u> <u>Products by Activity (CPA code)</u> referred to in this release as service products. Exceptions to this are the wholesale industry, which is collected at three-digit level, and the retail trade and waste collection, treatment and disposal activities industries, which are collected at five-digit level.

CPA products that are industry-specific are referred to as "on-diagonal"; these are products assumed most closely related to the business' main activities, based on businesses' industrial classification. In contrast, products that are outside a business' main industrial classification are referred to as "off-diagonal" products.
