Recorded Crime in Scotland, 2013-14

Since our meeting, we have been preparing the forthcoming statistical bulletin *Recorded Crime in Scotland, 2013-14* which we have been reviewing in terms of format and content, in line with best practice guidance. For information, the publication has been pre-announced for November 2014 but an exact date will be announced after the publication of the HMICS Crime Audit report to-morrow (Wed 12 Nov).

I am proposing to send you, under **pre-release access**, a draft section of the *Recorded Crime in Scotland, 2013-14* bulletin, for you to consider the type of commentary and graphs/charts which we have been developing. However, before doing so, I wanted to check that [REDACTED] would be available to review this material and provide any feedback/comments this week.

As one of a number of related documents which we have been preparing, we have also developed a Technical report entitled "Recorded Crime: Comparability of Police Scotland and Legacy Force Data". It would also be helpful to have your comments on this document.

However, the bulletin is our priority for comments as this would need to be with our publishers in advance of the other related documents which we are further developing and finalising. As I may have mentioned before, we also intend to consult on the bulletin after publication to assess where users would like further development.

I would be grateful if you could let me know if [REDACTED] would be able to review the extract from the bulletin and the technical report this week, please.
