
5. A launch date will not be shared internally (beyond the immediate team and the Senior Civil Service) or externally (except the Government Digital Service (GDS)). We will state an 'early 2016 launch', if asked. If we pass the GDS Service Assessment on the 16 December, the report is likely to be publically available from early January 2016. This will start to raise expectations of an imminent launch, if noticed.





Key messages


- 9. The proposed key messages are as follows.
