I hope that you will find this document useful and, as we have previously discussed, feed the sector and communities' views into ongoing development and decision making around this part of the census.

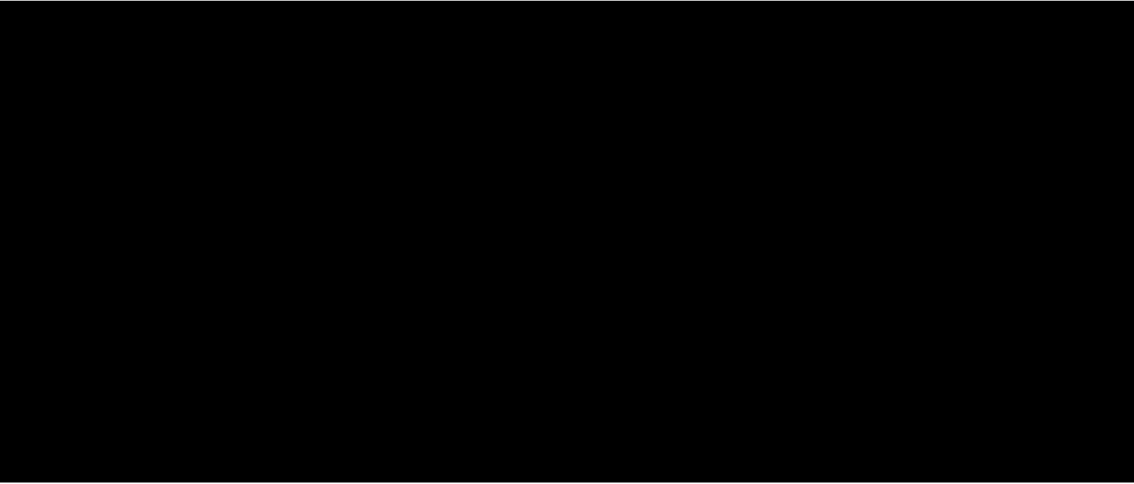
As always, I am available to answer any questions, provide information, and support any further engagement which you would like to pursue.
