

## Social Survey Division Publication Scheme and Charging Rates

In addition to the tables prepared for the standard outputs from ONS Social Surveys, tables may be independently commissioned, where practicable, when customer requirements are not met by data available in the published tables.

Commissioned tables will be issued to the requesting customer under an Open Government Licence (OGL) by the provision of a link to a URL on the ONS website and is also made available to all other users free of charge at the same time.

### Charging Rates

The cost of the commissioned output reflects the amount of time taken to develop the table(s) together with statistical disclosure check (pre- and post- production) and associated processes. The charges reflect the Full Economic Costs associated with the delivery of the service.

Six price bands have been identified to give customers a guide of how much their commissioned table(s) will cost. However, the customer services team will agree the final cost with the customer prior to any work commencing.

We will deliver the commissioned tables within 20 working days of receiving written acceptance of the quote, except in exceptional circumstances. In many cases, where requests are not complex, tables are delivered within 10 working days.

Set out below are the six price bands:
