# 1 Introduction

*Conception statistics 2001* presents final statistics on conceptions for women usually resident in England and Wales. This is a supplement to series FM1 no.31. Previously, conception statistics were published in the annual volume *Birth statistics* (series FM1).

Provisional figures for 2001 were presented in *Health Statistics Quarterly 17*<sup>2</sup> and provisional data for 2002 were published in *Health Statistics Quarterly 24*.<sup>3</sup> Final conception statistics for 2002 will be published in spring 2005.

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## 1.1 Tables in this supplement

The tables presented in this supplement are numbered Tables 12.1-12.8. This numbering convention has been adopted because these tables are a continuation of the tables previously published in *Birth statistics 2002*.<sup>1</sup> For brevity, the time series shown here have been limited to a run of 11 years at most. Figures for earlier years are shown in earlier volumes of *Birth statistics*.

## 1.2 Data analysed in this supplement

Conception statistics bring together records of birth registrations collected under the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1953 and of abortions under the Abortions Act 1967.

They include all the pregnancies of women usually resident in England and Wales which lead to one of the following outcomes:

- (i) a maternity at which one or more live births or stillbirths occur, which is registered in England and Wales;
- (ii) a termination of a pregnancy by abortion under the 1967 Act, in England and Wales.

Pregnancies which lead to spontaneous abortions (i.e. miscarriages) are not included. Maternities which result in one or more live births or stillbirths are counted once only.

The registration of life events (births, deaths and marriages) is a service carried out by the Local Registration Service in partnership with the General Register Office (GRO) in

Southport, which is part of ONS. Most of the information, for both live births and stillbirths, is supplied to registrars by one or other, or both of the parents. For stillbirths, details of cause of death, duration of pregnancy and weight of foetus are supplied on a certificate or notification by the doctor or midwife either present at the birth, or who examined the body. The certificate or notification is then taken by the informant to a registrar.

Further details on the information collected at birth or stillbirth can be found in section 1.2 of *Birth statistics 2002*.<sup>1</sup>

Information on abortions is derived from notifications supplied under the Abortions Act 1967. These are sent by registered practitioners to the Chief Medical Officer of the Department of Health, or to the Chief Medical Officer of the National Assembly for Wales. The details supplied include the woman's date of birth, marital status, and usual residence. Further details may be found in the ONS annual volume of *Abortion statistics*<sup>4</sup> and the Department of Health Statistical Bulletin *Abortion statistics, England and Wales: 2002*.<sup>5</sup>

## 1.3 Issues affecting the quality of the data in this supplement

Under arrangements made following implementation of the Abortion Act 1967, the Office for National Statistics and its predecessors processed and analysed the abortion notification forms (HSA4) sent to the Chief Medical Officers of England and Wales. From 1st April 2002, the Department of Health took over this work and a new system was introduced to process the new abortion notification forms that were made available from 18th April 2002. These changes temporarily slowed the processing of the forms. Data supplied to ONS by the Department of Health on abortions performed on residents of England and Wales between 1 April 2002 and 30 September 2002 contribute to the 2001 conception statistics presented in this supplement.

For further details of issues which affect the quality of birth statistics see *Birth statistics 2002*.<sup>1</sup>

## 1.4 Associated publications and the National Statistics website

The National Statistics website ([www.statistics.gov.uk](http://www.statistics.gov.uk)) provides a comprehensive source of freely available vital statistics and ONS products. More information on the National Statistics website can be obtained from ONS

(section 2.8). Detailed conception figures, including quarterly conceptions to women aged under 18, are published regularly on the National Statistics website.

### ***Figures for UK countries***

In Scotland, figures for conceptions are available for women aged under 20. The definition of conception in Scotland includes maternities (pregnancies ending in a live or stillbirth) and pregnancies resulting in a therapeutic abortion or miscarriage which required hospital inpatient or day-case treatment. The figures are available on the ISD website [www.isdscotland.org](http://www.isdscotland.org). There are no comparable conception figures for Northern Ireland.

### ***Population Trends and Health Statistics Quarterly***

Up to 1998 ONS published annual data in Monitors, known as the FM1 Series for conceptions and live births. These contained basic information on annual conceptions and live birth registrations, and were issued soon after the data became available. However, these publications have been discontinued and since 1999 these data have appeared in Reports issued in the quarterly journal *Population Trends*. Since the beginning of 1999, ONS has published two quarterly journals: *Population Trends*, which now has an emphasis on population and demography, covering most fertility topics, and *Health Statistics Quarterly*, covering mortality and health topics, and some other fertility data. The annual Report on conceptions by local and health authority areas is published in *Health Statistics Quarterly*. Quarterly reference tables on conceptions are published in both *Population Trends* and *Health Statistics Quarterly*.

## 2 Notes and definitions

### 2.1 Base populations

The population figures (shown in Appendices 1 and 2) which are used to calculate conception rates in this supplement, are mid-year estimates of the resident population of England and Wales based on the 2001 Census of Population. These estimates include members of HM and non-UK armed forces stationed in England and Wales, but exclude those stationed outside. ONS mid-year population estimates are updated figures using the most recent Census, allowing for births, deaths, net migration and ageing of the population.

Whenever results become available from the Census, a new base is created for the population estimates. Thus following the 2001 Census, ONS revised the mid-year population estimates from 1982 to 2000. Further revisions, though, subsequently occurred to the estimates from 1992. This is because further information from research following the Census became available. The research was carried out to understand the reasons for differences between the 2001 Census-based estimates and the mid-year estimates rolled forward from earlier censuses.

In this supplement, the population estimates used for the calculation of fertility rates are the latest consistent estimates available at the time of its production and were published as follows :-

#### Population Estimates by age and sex

- 2003 estimates; revised 2001 and 2002 estimates - published on 9 September 2004.
- 1992 to 2000 revised estimates - published on 7 October 2004.
- 1991 revised estimates - published on 13 February 2003.

#### Estimates by marital status

- 2003 marital status estimates - published on 4 November 2004.
- 1991 to 2000 marital status estimates; revised 2001 and 2002 marital status estimates - published on 7 October 2004.

These estimates incorporate the results of the local authority population studies, some other corrections and unattributable population change and have been revised since the publication of *Birth statistics 2002*.<sup>1</sup>

### 2.2 Areal coverage

Conception figures include only live births, stillbirths and abortions that occurred in England and Wales to women usually resident in England and Wales. Numbers and rates of conceptions are given by mother's usual area of residence based on Local Authority boundaries as at 31 December 2002 and Health Authority boundaries as at 1 April 2002. The postcode of the woman's address at the time of the maternity or abortion was used to assign the local authority and health authority of residence at the time of the conception. Direct comparisons with conceptions data by area published in previous years are not always possible because of boundary changes.

### 2.3 Estimating the date of conception

Information on the exact date of conception cannot be obtained from the registration details for either births or abortions. The date is estimated as follows:

#### *Maternities (one or more live births)*

The date of conception is estimated as 38 weeks before the date of birth. The average duration of pregnancy, or gestation period, measured between the first day of the last menstrual period and the date of birth, is 40 weeks; conception occurs on average 14 days after the first day of the last menstrual period.

#### *Maternities (all stillbirths)*

The date of conception is calculated as the date of birth less the stated gestation period.

#### *Abortions under the 1967 Act*

For conceptions in 1980 and earlier years, the date of conception is taken as the date of the start of the last menstrual period, plus 14 days. For conceptions in 1981 and subsequent years, it is taken as the date of termination less the stated gestation period, plus 14 days.

### 2.4 Estimating a woman's age at conception

A woman's age at conception is estimated from her date of birth, as stated on the birth registration or abortion notification, together with the estimated date of conception. In the small number of cases of maternities for which the woman's date of birth was not stated, an age is imputed using the date of birth stated on a previous comparable record. In the small number of cases of abortions where the

woman's date of birth was not recorded, the case is not used for statistical analysis.

The woman's age at conception is calculated as the interval in complete years between her date of birth and the date she conceived (estimated as described in section 2.3 above). However, where conception occurs in the same calendar month as the woman's birthday, this can result in the estimated age of mother at conception being either a year too low – if the baby is born live after less than 38 weeks – or a year too high – if the baby is born live at over 38 weeks. The method for estimating a woman's age at conception in such cases was revised in 1999 to take into account the mother's *day* of birth and *day* of conception in addition to the month and year as used previously. This resulted in a revision to figures published before 1999. All figures in this supplement are based on this revised methodology. A full explanation can be found in *Birth statistics 1998*.<sup>6</sup>

## 2.5 Conceptions within and outside marriage

A birth within marriage is that of a child born to parents who were lawfully married to each other either:

- a. at the date of the child's birth, or
- b. when the child was conceived, even if they later divorced or the father died before the child's birth.

Only for a birth within marriage will the registrar enter on the draft entry in the register confidential particulars relating to the date of the parents' marriage whether the mother has been married more than once, and the number of the mother's previous liveborn and stillborn children. Births occurring outside marriage may be registered either jointly or solely. A joint registration records details of both parents, and requires them both to be present. A sole registration records only the mother's details.

Conceptions outside marriage which lead to maternities within marriage are restricted here to those where birth occurred within 8 months (35 weeks) of marriage. However, the date of conception and age of woman at conception are estimated from a date 38 weeks before birth, as in the case of all other conceptions leading to live births.

For abortions, the categories of marital status distinguished on the form HSA4 are (a) single, (b) married, (c) widowed, (d) divorced and (e) separated. To calculate rates it is necessary to include separated with married because there are no population estimates for the 'separated' marital status category.

## 2.6 Legislation

The main statutes concerning birth registration and provision of information on births are given below:

- **Census Act 1920**, which in Section 5 provides for the collection and publication of statistical information on the population by the Registrar General.
- **Population Statistics Act 1938**, which deals with the statistical information collected at registration.
- **Births and Deaths Registration Act 1953**, which covers all aspects of the registration of births and deaths.
- **Registration Service Act 1953**, which in Section 19 requires the Registrar General to provide annual abstracts of live births and stillbirths.
- **Population Statistics Act 1960**, which makes further provision for collecting statistical detail at registration.
- **Abortions Act 1967**, which permits termination of pregnancy by a registered practitioner, subject to certain conditions.
- **Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages Regulations 1968**, which added questions on father's and mother's place of birth to the details requested at registration.
- **National Health Service Act 1977**, which requires notification of a birth to the health authority where the birth occurred.
- **Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act 1990**, Section 37 made changes to the Abortion Act 1967.
- **Stillbirth (Definition) Act 1992**, which altered the definition of a stillbirth to 24 or more weeks completed gestation, instead of the previous definition of 28 or more weeks completed gestation.
- **Health Act 1999**, a section of which includes specific provision for the supply of information on individual births to the National Health Service.

## 2.7 Symbols and conventions

In this volume:

- : denotes 'not appropriate'
- 0 denotes less than 0.5
- denotes nil.

Where data are not yet available, cells in tables are left blank. Rates calculated from fewer than 20 events are distinguished by italic type as a warning to users that their reliability as a measure may be affected by the small number of events. To protect confidentiality, all counts lower than 5, and all rates based on fewer than 5 events, have been suppressed. Occasionally it has been necessary to apply a secondary suppression to avoid the possibility of disclosure by differencing. Figures in some tables in this publication may not add up due to rounding.
